## Continental Hydraulics merges with Hydreco in NA

Duplomatic Group announced that Continental Hydraulics Inc. and Hydreco Inc. have merged their North American operations becoming a single company.

Duplomatic Group said that this step might seem like a simple organizational or financial change, but it represents the implementation of one of the pillars of the strategic development of the group: the synergy between the brands allows to offer a catalogue of products and services capable of satisfying the

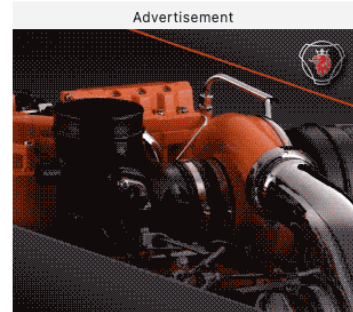
needs of many companies through a single technology partner in motion control.

The two customer service teams will now work interactively and will be gradually interchangeable, so that customers can now contact either office for Hydreco product line.

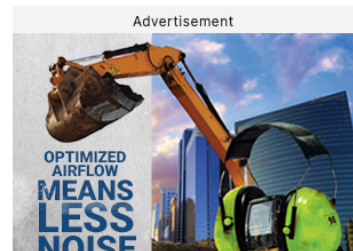
